

## **BY- LAW**

### **NO. 3**

**ISSUE:** Use and allocation of craft

**COMMENCED:** 10/9/2009

**LAST UPDATED:** 10/11/2011

#### **PROVISIONS:**

##### Use of craft

1. Subject to clause 2, all club owned craft (not including boats) are available for use by suitably qualified members (i.e. proficient SRC/BM members).
2. At least once a year, the Club Head Coach, Surf Sports Director and Gear Steward (or such other persons as may be determined by the Executive Committee) will review the condition of all club owned craft (not including boats) to determine if individual craft, because of their condition, should not be available for use by members.

##### Allocation of craft

3. Craft (boards and skis) may be allocated to members for their use throughout the season for competition and training. Skis will be available only to U17 & U19 members of the club.
4. All craft retained for allocation to club members will be second generation craft.
5. Any member allocated craft will be required to pay \$100 hire fee for the season.
6. Craft will be allocated for one season only and eligibility for future allocation will be reviewed on a season by season basis. Members are required to reapply for allocation each season.
7. All applications for craft allocation will be considered by the Executive Committee which will base its decisions on the member's –
  - (i) Record of competition in surf carnivals,
  - (ii) Consistency of attendance at carnivals,
  - (iii) Approach and application to training,
  - (iv) Compliance with the patrol, membership and other obligations of the club.

- (v) Potential for improvement in performance outcomes.
8. All requests for craft allocation must be made in writing to the Surf Sports Director. The application must at a minimum include information on past results, training being undertaken and details of the member's goals for the season and beyond.
  9. The Surf Sports Director will review the application and make a recommendation to the Executive Committee. The Executive Committee is not obliged to accept any recommendation of the Competition Director and any decision of the Executive Committee is final.
  10. Any decision of the Executive Committee to approve craft allocation will be subject to the following conditions –
    - (i) The member must comply with all patrol requirements
    - (ii) Unless otherwise exempted by the Surf Sports Director, the member must compete in the club championships, Freshwater Australia Day carnival, SNB Branch, State and Australian championships and all other nominated carnivals as may be determined by the Surf Sports Director or Club Head Coach
    - (iii) the member must attend all relevant scheduled training sessions unless otherwise exempted by the Surf Sports Director or Club Head Coach
    - (iv) the member must at all times not engage in any behaviour that is unbecoming or prejudicial to the objects and interests of the Club or is likely to bring the Club and or surf life saving into disrepute
    - (v) any craft allocated remains at all times the property of the Club
    - (vi) the member must attend nominated fundraising events as may be determined by the Surf Sports Director, the Club presentation night, and squad/team meetings unless otherwise exempted by the Surf Sports Director and or the Club Head Coach.
    - (vii) the member must compete in club clothing in all team and individual events unless otherwise required by the carnival rules and must wear club clothing when in attendance at the Australian Surf Titles.
    - (viii) the member is to pay the club \$100.
  11. If a member cannot meet the conditions outlined in clause 8, the Executive Committee shall have the power to terminate the arrangement and resume the craft. Any craft resumed may also be reallocated to another competing member at the discretion of the Surf Sports Director.
  12. Any craft allocated to a member is to be returned to the club at the conclusion of the Australian Surf Titles.

13. A member who is allocated a craft is required to sign the Acceptance of Terms and Conditions attached to this By-law. In the case of a member under the age of 18 years, a parent or guardian's signature is also required.

**ACCEPTANCE OF TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR CRAFT ALLOCATION**

Having been allocated a board/ski as detailed below, acknowledge and agree that I will do the following –

1. Comply with all patrol requirements
2. Unless otherwise exempted by the Surf Sports Director, compete in the club championships, Freshwater Australia Day carnival, SNB Branch, State and Australian championships and all other nominated carnivals as may be determined by the Surf Sports Director or Club Head Coach.
3. Attend relevant scheduled training sessions unless otherwise exempted by the Surf Sports Director or Club Head Coach.
4. Not engage in any behaviour that is unbecoming or prejudicial to the objects and interests of the Club or is likely to bring the Club and or surf life saving into disrepute.
5. Be responsible for the payment for repairs for any damage caused outside of competition or official training unless otherwise exempted by the Surf Sports Director.
- 6., Obtain a cover for the board for use when in storage or when being transported to and from carnivals and or training.
7. Wash down and store the craft securely in a rack within the Club's premises except when being held away from the Club premises for the purposes of travel to carnivals and or training.
8. Attend nominated fundraising events, Club presentation night and squad/team meetings unless otherwise exempted by the Surf Sports Director or Club Head Coach
9. Compete in club clothing in all team and individual events and wear club clothing when in attendance at the Australian Surf Titles

I also understand that if I breach of any of these conditions, the Club has the right to resume the craft and re-allocate it to another member.
