- Whilst every effort will be made to adhere to the timetable, team managers should be aware that changes may be made throughout the day at the discretion of the Carnival Referee.
- All events will be run through to Finals.
- 07:30 AM report for 08:00AM start
- Registration for all Water & Beach competitions from 06:30 AM to 09:00 AM, on the grass area in front of Manly LSC. No Tag = No Start. Late entries on the day are Cash Only.
- Boat Sweeps please note the program on the ASRL website. 06:30 AM Sweeps Meeting. 07:00 AM start both boat areas
- U13's are NOT permitted to compete. Events will not be held for competitors attempting to compete in more than one age group.
- Hi-Viz Pink Rash Vests are compulsory for all water events (and are not supplied). Any competitor with faded vests will be requested to replace their vests.
- Only Semi Finalists of the **Open Iron Person**, and Finalist of the **U15/U17/U19 Iron Person** will qualify for the **Freshwater** Iron Person events.
- Composite teams are permitted but may be restricted by the event referees depending on the number of teams per event.

NOTE: NO CLUB TENTS ARE PERMITTED AT THE END OF THE CORSO ABOVE THE CORSO STEPS OR ON THE BEACH.

- Hi-Viz Pink Rash Vests are compulsory for all water events (and are not supplied). Any competitor with faded vests will be requested to replace their vests.
- Only Semi Finalists of the **Open Iron Person**, and Finalist of the **U15/U17/U19 Iron Person** from the Manly Open carnival on Saturday will participate in the **Freshwater** Iron Person events.
