PLANTING AND UNVEILING **OF THE QE2 JUBILEE TREE**

The tree-planting ceremony to mark the late Queen's Jubilee was delayed by both her passing, and the advent of summer. The tree planting is now confirmed for Friday 24 March, at 10am. The Federal Member, Zali Steggall, will undertake the planting in the presence of James Griffin MP and Mayor Michael Regan. The tree selected is a Queensland Tree Waratah (Alloxylon Flammeum). The unveiling of the planted tree will be held on 14 April at 11.15am by the Governor of NSW in company with Local Members and dignitaries. As it is a Vice-Regal occasion, smart casual attire is required with the wearing of medals for those to whom that applies.

After the tree unveiling, the Governor, Her Excellency the Honourable Margaret Beazley AC,KC, will then depart for the Roden Cutler Sports Luncheon at the Harbord Diggers Club organised by the Harbord RSL sub-Branch.



FRESHWATER SOLDIERS STORIES

Wendy Machon has been working consistently on these stories alongside our work on the wording of footpath memorial plaques. These 20-plus stories were at the point of needing a professional editor and Liz Hardy took up the task. Funds came from the first payment of \$2,000 from the estate of the late John Thorpe, plus \$1,850 from the State Government's Community War Memorial Fund . The next step is to bring this work to publication.

FOOTPATH **MEMORIAL PLAOUES**

On 8 February, five memorial plaques were installed on the northern side of lower Soldiers Avenue. The plague of "lodine Joe" Saunders is completed and will be installed once construction adjacent to the site is completed.

We are now in a position to acquit the Community Building Partnership Grant received from the State Government.

WW2 SOLDIERS

We will need to give consideration to commemoration of famous Freshwater WW2 service personnel in footpath spaces available in upper Soldiers Avenue. These people might include Mackie Campbell, Peter Lumsdaine, Megs Madigan, Bill Messenger and Harry Knox to name but a few. None of these have been recognised locally for their service except by their names on Harbord Diggers/Watermark buildings.

Fitz Perry, a photographer and friend Charles Penny, both closely associated with the Freshwater area and Surf Club, lived at Fitz Perry's family home in Queenscliff Road, Queenscliff, Both Perry and Penny left Australia 28 December 1916 on the "Ascanius" arriving in France on 7 April 1917 with the 19th Battalion, 17th Reinforcement. 8 days later, on the 15 April 1917, they were both killed in action at Lagnicourt, France. Fitz Perry, was buried at the Noreuil Australian Cemetery, near Bapaume, France.

Perry was 32 Charles Edward Penny, was buried in the vicinity of Lagnicourt, France. Penny was 44
