The Freshwater team travelled to Coolangatta once again to participate in Surf Life Savings iconic endurance event the Coolangatta Gold.

This year saw a larger Freshie contingent from youth, under 19's and Masters with a combination of individuals and teams competing. All competitors elected to do the short course which comprises of a 10.5 kilometre Ski Paddle, 2 kilometre swim, 3 kilometre board paddle and a 5.5 kilometre run a total of 21 kilometres. The youth challenge is a 350 metre swim, 450 metre board paddle and total run distance of 800 metres.

In the over 60's the man who loves train Michael "Killer" Kirkby finished a close second to the race leader and has started training for next year already. In his first attempt Liam Lehane finished a very creditable 7th and loved every minutes of the race and the weekend.
