

CONGRATULATIONS TO OUR R&R TEAMS AT STATE

This season's State R&R Championships were again held at Freshwater over two weekends. The first weekend saw the junior events held. Again this year Freshwater was not able to field any teams in either the two or five person events. Given many clubs had multiple teams competing across the various age groups, it remains disappointing this event, which promotes lifesaving skills, appears unattractive to the Freshwater junior cohort.

The second weekend involved the senior component and Freshwater had two teams competing. The Open Men's 5 (Seb Di Sano, Ian Donald, Patrick Kiely, Chris Tyrrell & Hugo Weston) won the gold medal and in doing so successfully defended the title they won last year. The Open 6 Person team (the men's combination plus Jarrad Freakley) also won the gold medal and in doing so were the only team over the two weekends who managed a score of zero. This was the 10th time in 15 years the team has won the event and the coveted Harry Nightingale Trophy.

CONGRATULATIONS TO OUR MASTERS TEAMS AT STATE

With a very strong showing at Branch titles the Freshie Masters took to the water and beach at Queenscliff for the Masters State Championships. Weather conditions on both days were great sometimes bordering on too hot with solid and testing surf conditions which took the sword to many competitors dashing their hopes of State Championship glory.

We kicked off the first day (Individual events) with our two lone beach competitors Michael Kirkby and Tom Duffy representing, Tom in his Masters State Title debut coming away with a silver in the 2km beach run and Killer with a 4th.

We had many medal winners with some standout performances on day I namely - Phil Bird winning gold in the board and ironman and a silver in the ski, Ben Kirkby winning the ski and bronze in the board, Dave Bredeson with gold in the rescue tube and silver in the surf race and Al Burns with silver in the surf race and rescue tube.

Day two is the teams day and we again multiple medal winners and placings across all events and age groups with our the 170 Male Swim team of John de Mestre, Andrew de Vries and Dave "de" Bredeson coming away with gold.

Thursday post event we held a debrief at the Harbord Hotel where the inevitable stories of what could have been, and what was were shared over a beer and wine.

While official overall results have not been listed on Live Heats it looks like Freshie finished inside the top 10 and around 8th overall in the point score.


George Mullins Jr Receives Freshie Club Blazer

George Mullins is one of Freshwater's SLSC's most esteemed and longest serving members. He originally joined Freshie as a Cadet in the early 1950's and immediately won the Club's Cadet Surf Race Championship in both 1953 and 1954! George excelled in most surf lifesaving disciplines winning many awards and championships in Surf and Board events. Most notably being part of our 1959/1960 all-conquering Champion Rescue and Resuscitation Team.. He has been a life saver all his life, becoming a professional permanent lifeguard supervisor and beach inspector for Sydney Northern Beach Councils for many years before moving to Queensland to undertake further lifeguard duties on the Gold Coast and Sunshine Coast.

George continues to support and be involved in many Club activities, most notably the Barney Mullins Swim Classic. This was established in 1986 and is named after his Dad and Freshwater swim legend George 'Barney' Mullins. And, now, his son, George, travels from Queensland each year to attend race day, scheduled this year on Saturday 23 March.
